Re: Clarke v Wild & Anr

I acknowledge receipt of your papers, received in this office on 19th November 2012.

Your papers were referred to the Deputy Master of the Civil Appeals office who has asked me to inform you of the Following:

“The applicant has filed an appellant’s notice seeking to appeal the order of Mr Justice Peter Jackson dated 24th October 2012 which is an order made on paper following decisions of the court dated 31 July 2012 and 9 July 2012.

The application for permission to appeal the order to the Court of Appeal is premature because it does not appear that the applicant has exhausted the jurisdiction of the Court of Protection. Pursuant to CPR Rule 89 where the court makes an order without a hearing a party may apply to the court for a reconsideration of the order. The applicant should therefore now consider applying out of time for such a reconsideration.

Accordingly as the jurisdiction of the Court of Protection is not exhausted the papers are to be returned.”
